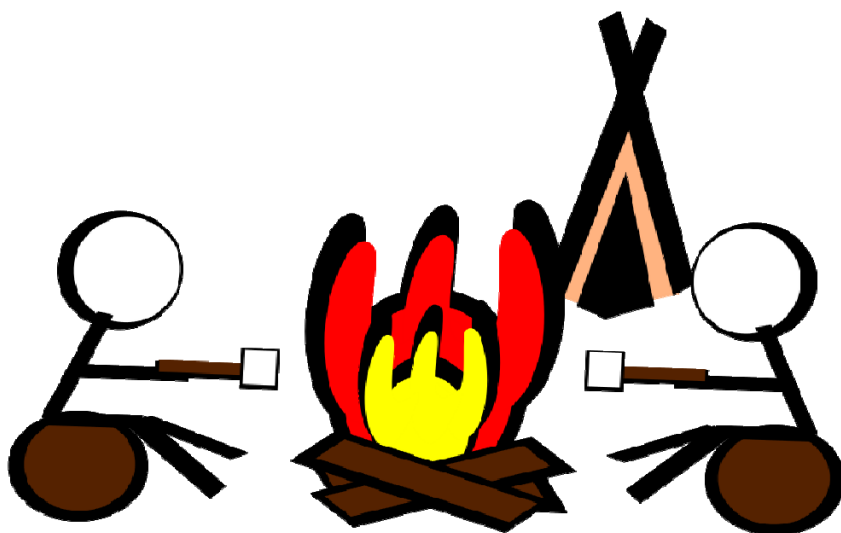

## 6TH GRADE PARENTS

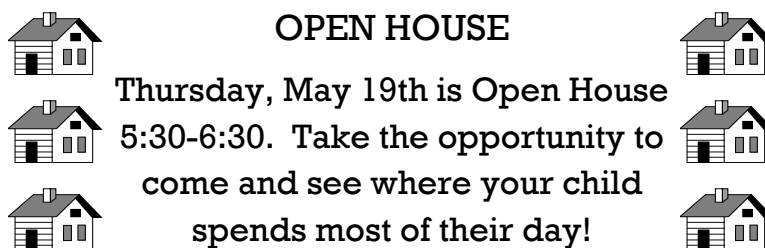

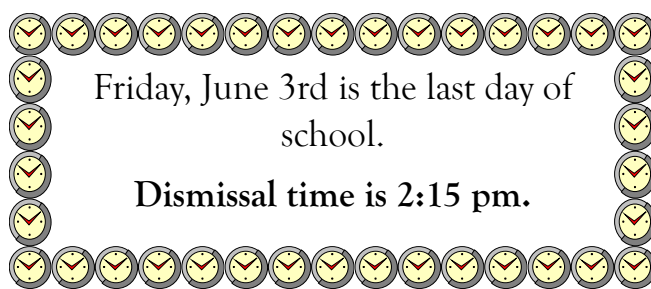


Turn in your BOX TOPS before the end of the year to earn cash for FHS!
